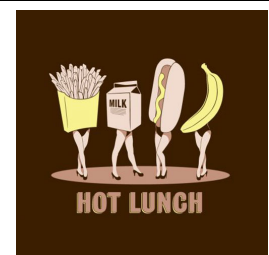
Guest Speaker for Wed, February 10th PAC meeting (6:30pm start):
